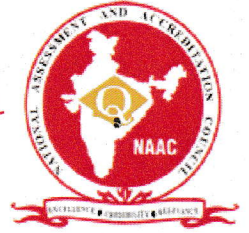

Observation:

1) Overall quality of employable students

3) Knowledge of ethics and social awareness among students

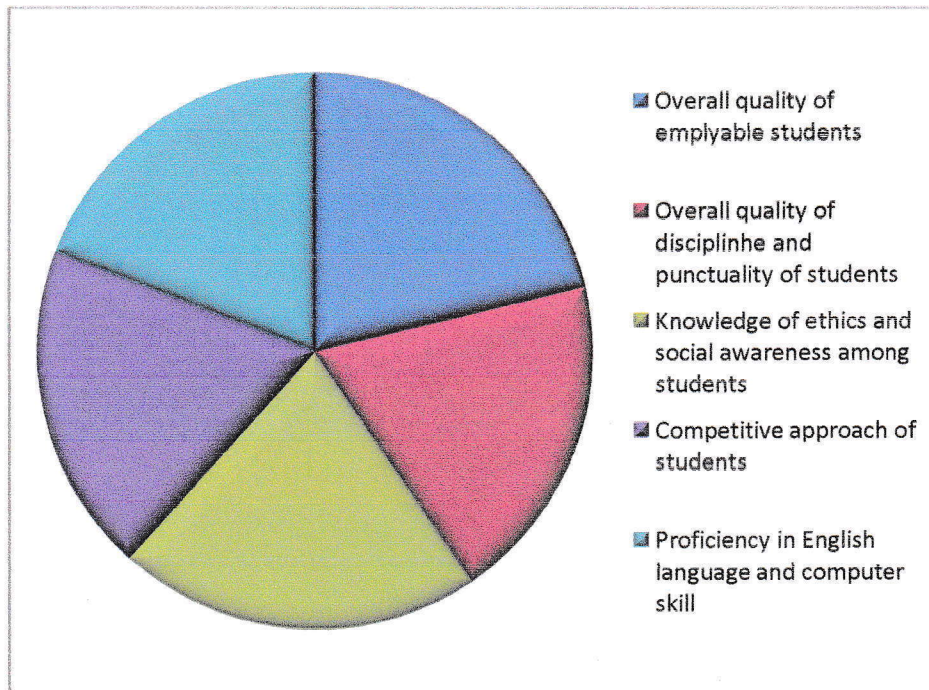
Over 92% respondents believe that they do possess ethics and social awareness. It is pride possession that our students are morally and ethically good and socially aware.
