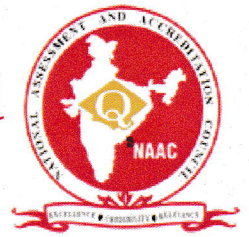

Employers Feedback- 2020-2021

From 2017-2018 session, the institution has introduced feedback from the employers. This is aimed at knowing the perception of the employers about our students. All together we have received 03 responses from various fields and after analysis, following report is generated.

Observation:

1) Overall quality of employable students

Around 63% expressed satisfaction regarding the overall quality of our students.

2) Overall quality of discipline and punctuality of students

It is also found that 83% of the employers appeared to be satisfied.

3) Knowledge of ethics and social awareness among students

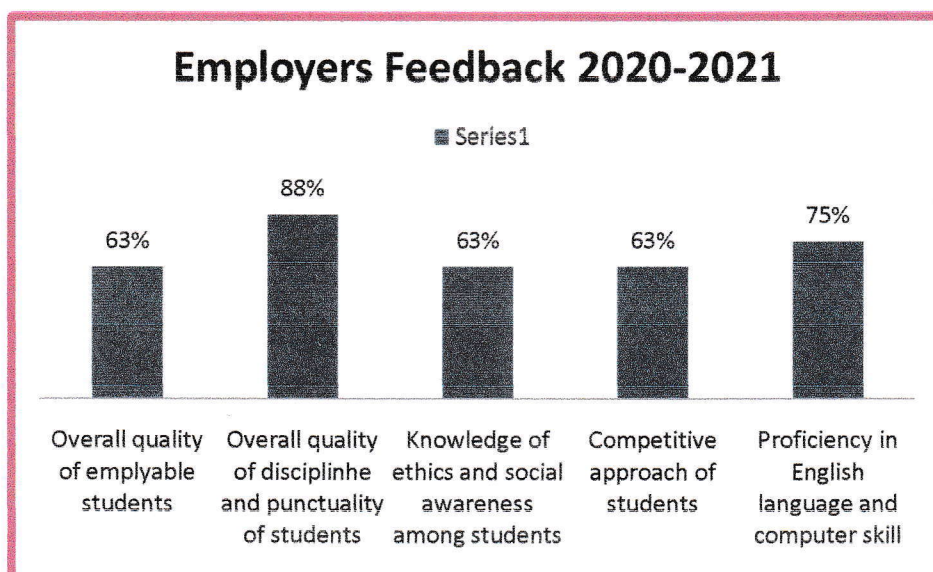
