Observation:

1) Overall quality of employable students

Around 92% expressed satisfaction regarding the overall quality of our students.

2) Overall quality of discipline and punctuality of students

It is also found that 92% of the employers appeared to be satisfied.

3) Knowledge of ethics and social awareness among students

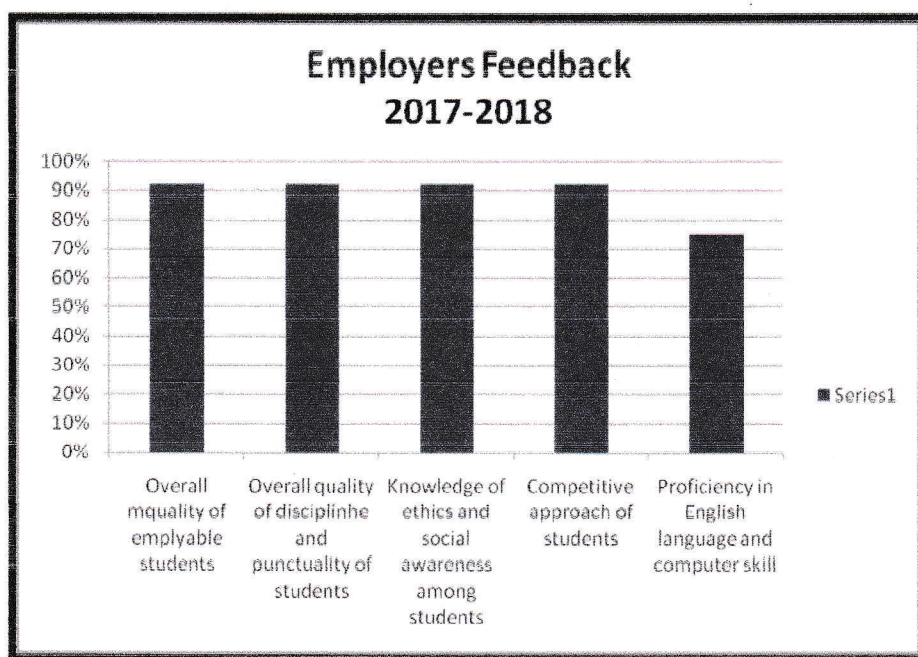
