Year 2020 observes the bicentennial birth year of Pandit Iswar Chandra Vidyasagar. He is regarded as one of the prominent intellectuals in the making of modern Bengal. The Bengalee society owes its traits of modernity and progressiveness to Vidyasagar. The birth of modern and progressive Bengal was possible due to tireless efforts of people



like him. His rationality, humanism and strong sense of commitment to emancipate women inspired him to initiate reform programmes to rescue the Bengali society which was hitherto immersed in the darkness of illiteracy, superstition and abject neglect of women folk. His firm faith in humanism induced him to introduce widow re-marriage and ban on child marriage and polygamy. Despite stiff opposition from the orthodox section of Bengalee hindus, he arranged widow remarriage, and succeeded to convince the Ra to promulgate laws in this regard. His faith in the efficacy of education in bringing about desired changes in the then contemporary society encouraged him to spread education and establish schools in different parts of Bengal.

On his bicentennial birth year, this webinar hopes to be a modest tribute to the great soul o humanity

A Brief Discussion

Role of Vidyasagar in 19th Century

Prof. Ashokendu Sengupta dealt with the upbringing of Vidyasagar to understand his reforms agenda.
Like another modern man, Vidyasagar hid his religious identity from the glare of the public eye and tried
to help all the people irrespective of religion and gender.

Prof. Sengupta reminded the audience it is the Bengali language that attracted his (Vidyasagar) attention significantly. Development of Bengali letters is inter-connected with the spread of literacy. He owned a press and published lots of books and pamphlets for the Bengalees.

He was entrusted by the British government and he faithfully accomplished them.

Brian Hatcher delivered **his** speeches on Vidyasagar's efforts on the various types of discriminations meted out against the women in Bengal like widow remarriage, polygamy, child marriage, female illiteracy even superstitions. Prof. Hatcher deals with efforts of Vidyasagar to ameliorate the poor conditions of the women suffering from.

Widow remarriage, female literacy drive, raising the age of marriage, steps against polygamy etc. Vidyasagar is also regarded as the Ocean of Piety (Doyar Sagar)

. Research Opportunity on Vidyasagar and Modern India

Regarding research scope and opportunity on the issues of 19th century Bengali society and reforms agenda, both the resource persons believe that Vidyasagar can be taken seriously as a research topic. Issues like Vidysagar, reforms movement, modern India, nationalism, renaissance etc.

Dr. Satrajit Banerjee asks a question on vidyasagar and both speakers satisfy him. Apart from that, many participants asked questions to both speakers and they answered satisfactorily.
