The constitution was adopted by the Indian Constituent Assembly on 26 November 1949 and came into effect on 26 January 1950. January 26 was chosen as the date for Republic Day as it was on that day in 1930 when the Declaration of Indian Independence was proclaimed by the Indian National Congress. Celebrating Independence Day is a challenge because the whole world is affected by a new virus **COVID-19**.

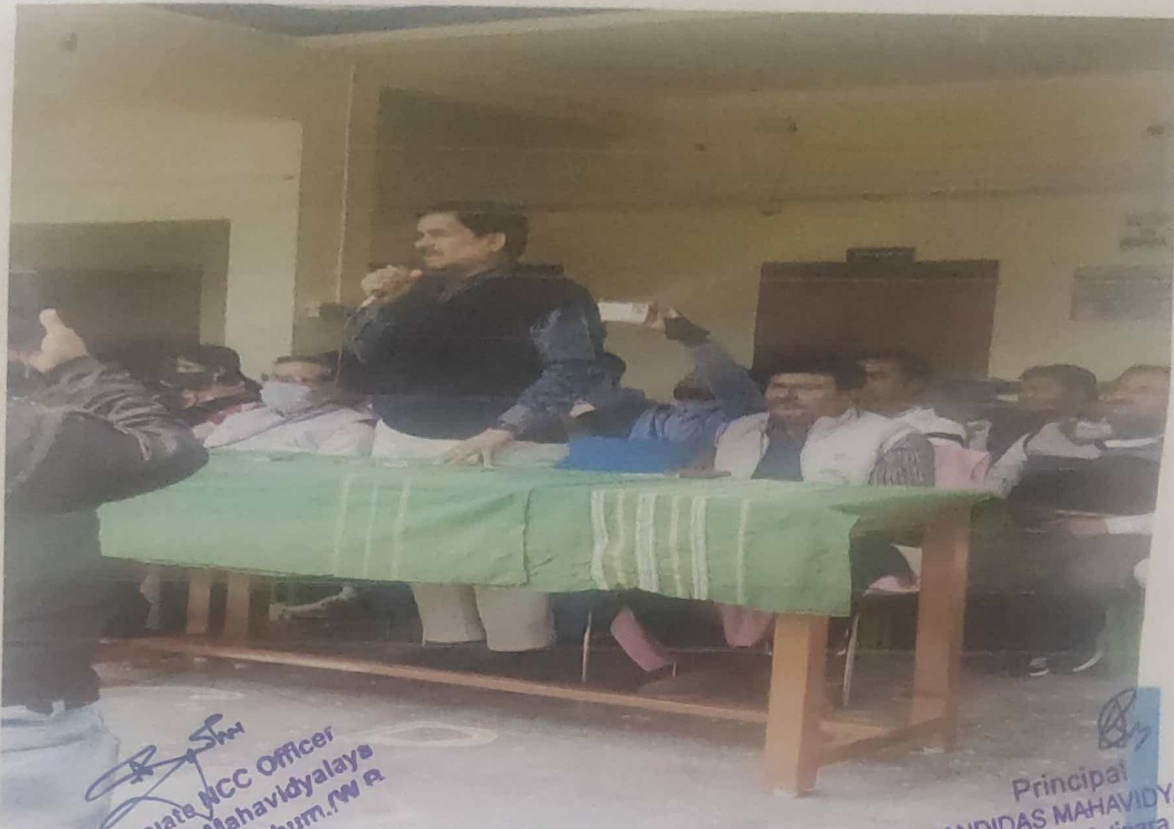
