

Republic Day is the day when India marks and celebrates the date on which the Constitution of India came into effect on 26 January 1950. This replaced the Government of India Act 1935 as the governing document of India, thus turning the nation into a republic separate from British Raj. The constitution was adopted by the Indian Constituent Assembly on 26 November 1949 and came into effect on 26 January 1950. January 26 was chosen as the date for Republic Day as it was on that day in 1930 when the Declaration of Indian Independence was proclaimed by the Indian National Congress.

- (i) Remembering the great people of freedom movement by celebrating Republic Day
- (ii) To keep the great ideals of freedom movement alive in the public through annual celebrations
- (iii) Paying respect to the country
- (iv) The constitution mentions the equality of all irrespective of caste, religion and caste etc.

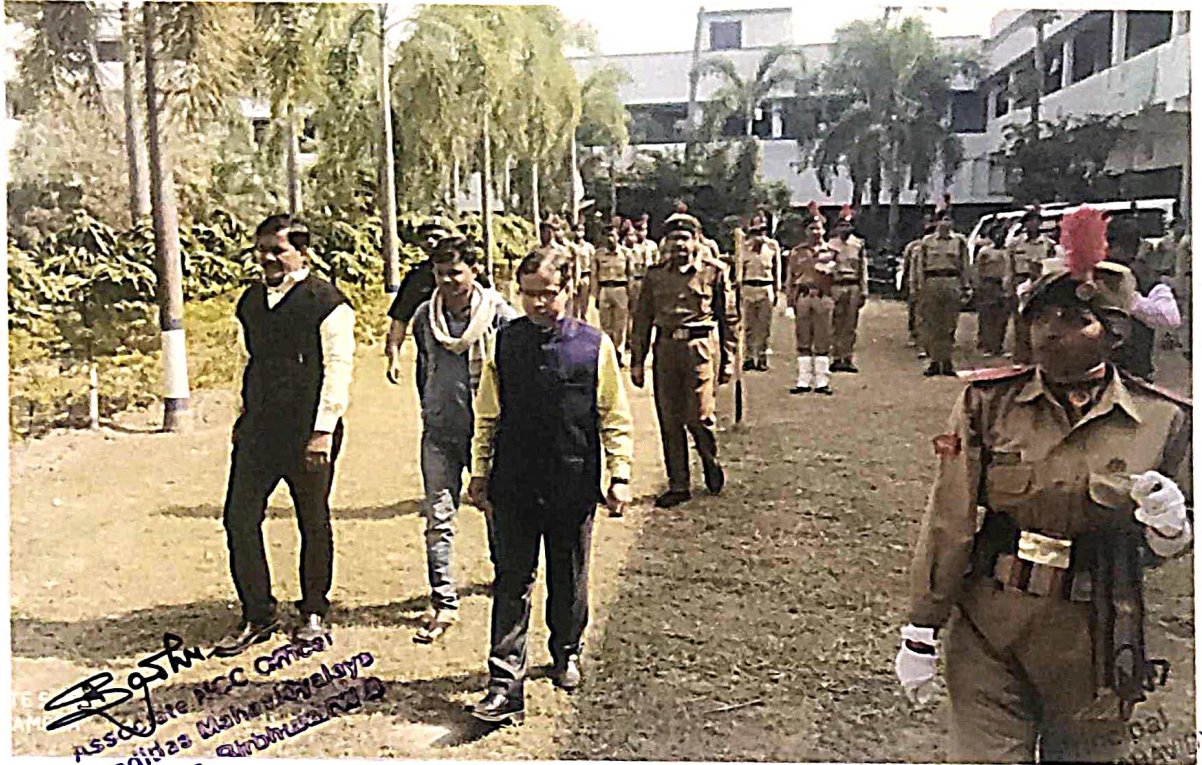
