



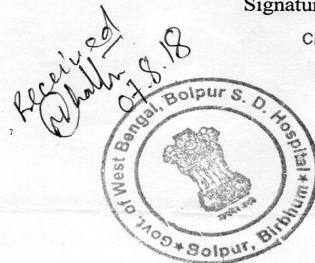

- No. of Beneficiaries – 100 volunteers and whole villagers of Basapara
- Brief Report of the Program – “Not me, But You” with this motto our NSS Unit was adopted a village to develop as a community service. A Seven-day Special camp was organized for that. During those days near about 100 NSS volunteers and two NSS POs were actively involved in that campsite. We have done various programs in that special camp, such as Village Cleaning, Health Hygiene & Sanitation Prog, Economical fundamental with banking systems, Rural Development Strategy, Prevention of early marriage or any Social backlogs, Health Camp and many cultural Programs in those days. We did a Cancer Awareness Program in that Special Camp.
- Outcomes of the Program -
 - A Seven-Day Special Camp in Adopted Village gave a potential to our NSS volunteers to involve directly or indirectly in our society to do something good.
 - Our students cum NSS volunteers were engaged and capable for this kind of community develop program.
 - Our volunteers were connected with the villagers and they feel very confident about their public skill.
 - Villagers and all the community have gather some essential knowledge about their financial banking system.
