Anti Ragging Initiative

Ragging is any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness to any student, including in rowdy or undisciplined activities which cause or likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the psyche of a fresher or a junior student. Further, UGC has notified via the 3rd amendment in UGC Regulations on 29th June, 2016 to expand the definition of ragging by including the following:

"Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background."

Anti Ragging Measures

These two committees are headed by the Principal. All the students admitted to the college have to observe and abide by the rules prescribed by the UGC. To enhance familiarity and to acclimatise the fresher's to the academic and social environment of the campus, an orientation programme is generally held in the first week of the new academic calendar. Different communication mechanisms are used to disseminate the information about the anti-ragging measures being followed at the college. At various corner of the campus warning stating "Zero tolerance policy in Ragging" "Be aware Raggars" etc. are displayed to aware the students. Apart from these the provision of punishment as per IPC is also displayed in the campus to warn the probable offender.

Regular interaction and counselling sessions are held with the students to make them comfortable in the new environment and to detect any signs of ragging. The anti-ragging squad regularly visits canteen/union office and sports ground to detect any signs of ragging. In addition, there is surprise inspection at canteens, common rooms, toilets zone, garage area etc to prevent ragging and any undesirable behaviour or incident.

Complaint Mechanism: Complaints against any student indulging in ragging should be immediately brought to the notice any of the members of Anti-Ragging Squad.

The Complaint can be made either in writing or telephonically or in digital form – email or what's app, link as provided on the college web site. The Complaints can be made by the victim student or any friend of the victim student or the Class Representative of the Student or by any person having knowledge of the incident.

The Complaints made to be the Anti-Ragging Cell will be Confidential and not made public in any manner.

Action taken against the students found guilty: Upon investigation and complete impartial scrutiny of the matter by the Anti-Ragging Cell, the students found guilty will be expelled or suspended or dismissed from the College and F.I.R. will be lodged with the Police against them under the respective laws. However, if upon investigation it is found that the alleged complaint is frivolous, false and complete baseless, then action will be taken against the respective student.

Prevention of Sexual Harassment

Sexual Harassment: Any act or behaviour of any kind of -a) Physical contact or advances, b) a demand or request for sexual favours c) sexually coloured remark d) showing pornography e) any other unwelcome physical, verbal or non verbal conduct of sexual nature will be treated as Sexual harassment in the workplace and results a violation of the fundamental rights of a woman to equality under articles 14 and 15 of the Constitution of India and her right to life and to live with dignity under article 21 of the Constitution and right to practice any profession or to carry on any occupation, trade or business which includes a right to a safe environment free from sexual harassment.
