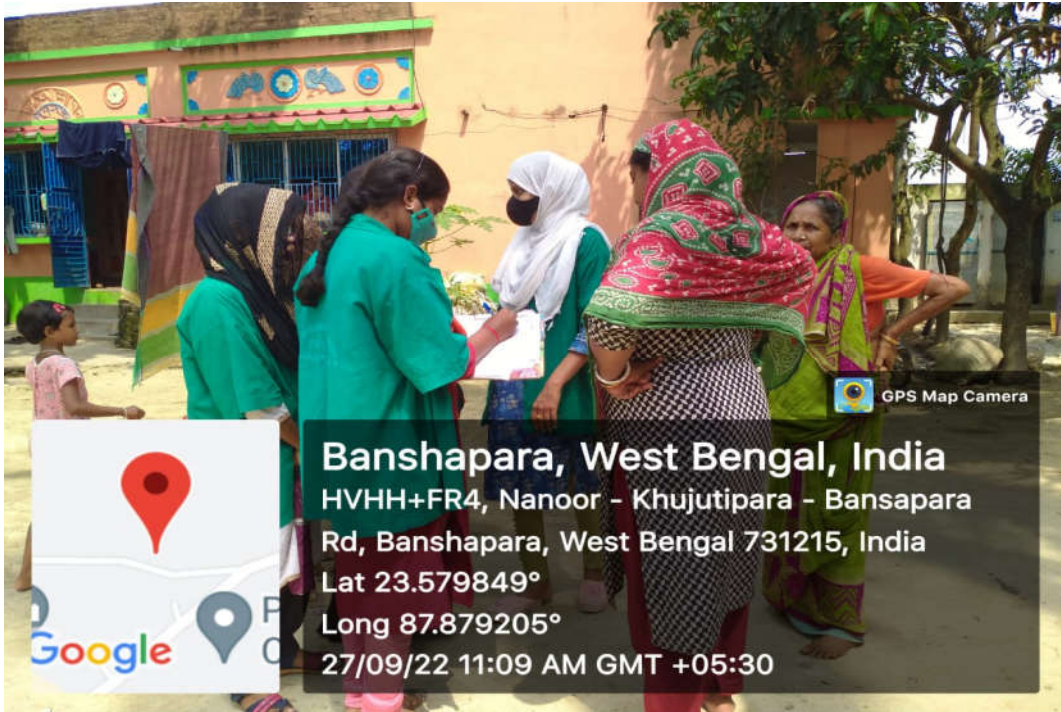
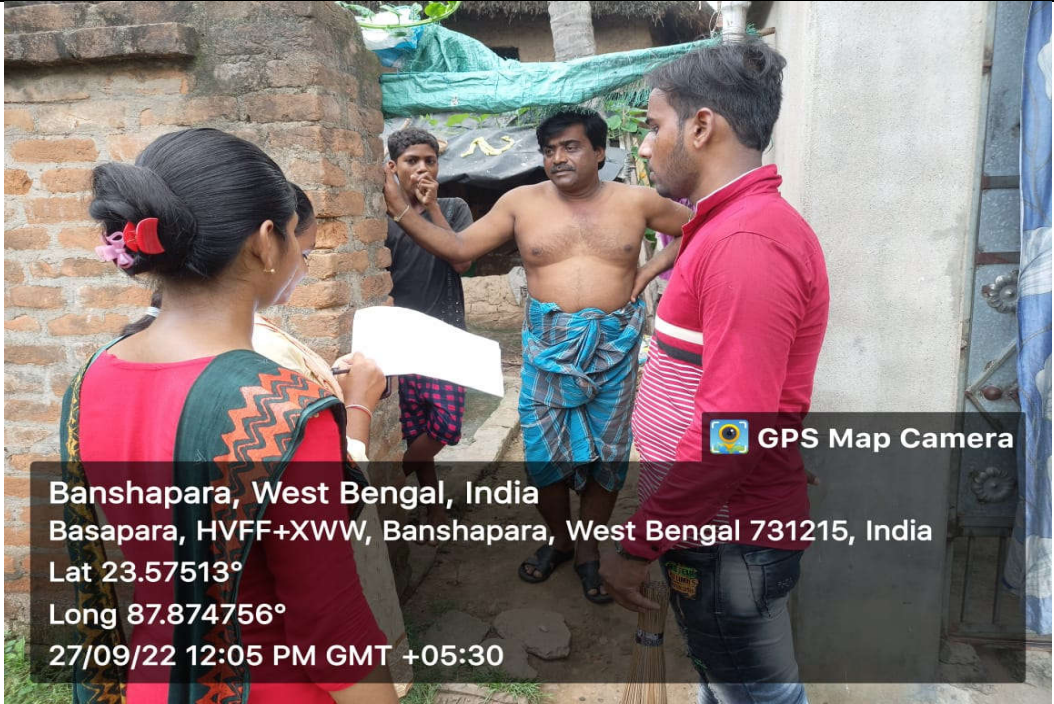
REPORT OF 7 DAYS SPECIAL CAMP

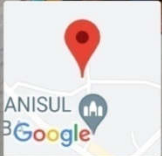

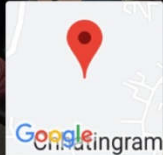
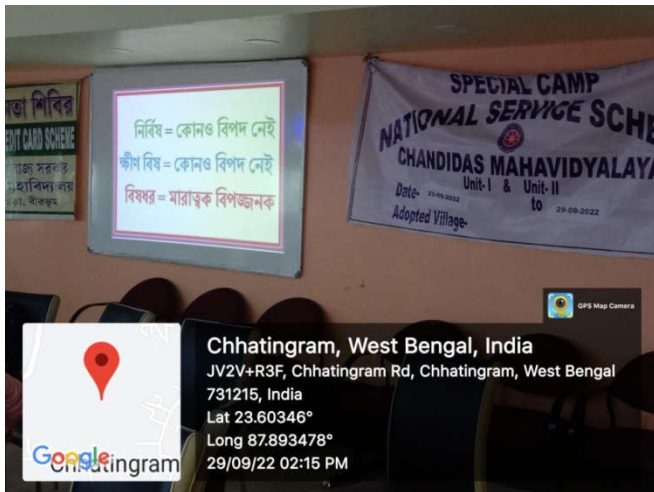
