### **Brief discussion:**

### **Issues of Current Democracy in India**

Research on any topic can be done following qualitative or quantitative methods. Prof. Bhattacharya shares the name of departments and the university where issues of Indian politics can be taken for research.

After his completion of the lecture, numerous questions are raised and Dr. Bhattacharya deftly handles them.
