Brief discussion:

The departmental seminar is presided over by the Principal, Dr. Sk. Ataur Rahaman.

Issues of Current Democracy in India

Dr. Bhattacharya expresses gratitude to the department for inviting him to deliver a lecture. He also thanks the audience for attending his lecture. He deals with the issue of Indian democracy from the

Starting from JNU agitation to the Singur movement, he moves up and down riding on a theoretical proposition. In the west, democracy came after capitalist development matured; but Indian democracy followed economic development first. Research on any topic can be done following qualitative or quantitative methods. Prof. Bhattacharya shares the name of departments and the university where issues of Indian politics can be taken for research.

After his completion of the lecture, numerous questions are raised and Dr. Bhattacharya deftly handles them. Golam Masum, Assistant Professor, Bolpur College thanks him for the nice presentation and pledges to convey the same message to his students.
