### Report on Dream Selling among children of the nearby school



### Report

Chandidas Mahavidyalaya, as an educational institution, has always strived to create a positive impact on the surrounding area of Khujutipara and its inhabitants whether it be through its NSS wing or other socially oriented activities. With such an objective in mind, on 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2021, under the 'Selling Dreams' initiative, the college organized a special tour for the students of the neighbouring Primary School, Khujutipara Prathamik Vidyalaya to help them understand and appreciate the significance of higher education.

42 children from the school visited the college premises under close and cordial association and supervision of many teachers and non-teaching staff of the college. A few teachers from the students' school were also with the children to co-operate and escort them. The program began with a small motivational speech by the principal of Chandidas Mahavidyalaya, Dr. Sk. Ataur Rahaman, who tried to explain the need and scope of higher education to inspire them. The principal's speech was followed by the showing of a couple of brief animated, motivational videos to further evoke interest in the young minds. The children were then given a tour of the entire college: they were shown through the classrooms – normal and ICT-enabled, the seminar room, the library, the auditorium, the sports and the gym rooms and so on to help them better understand and envision what studying in a college entails. The program ended with the giving of a small token and chocolates to the children and by asking for their feedback on their overall experience. The children's response was overwhelmingly positive and they even looked forward to visiting again in the future.

In conclusion, the endeavour was successful since it managed to achieve its objective of creating interest and motivation in the minds of the school children to pursue higher studies and help the children become more sensitized towards issues of social, political and ethical relevance.
